

# Bug Fight Workshop (In Schools)

**Bug Fight**! Is a workshop for KS4 students to find out more about Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) and what Oxford researchers are doing to combat this growing concern.

Bug Fight will introduce Year 10 and Year 11 students to antibiotics, enzyme, substrates and inhibitors. They will learn how antibiotic-resistant bacteria evolve and consider how we can make new drugs to fight antibiotic-resistant bugs. This workshop is offered in collaboration with the Ineos Oxford Institute for Antimicrobial Research (IOI).

#### Audience

Year 10-11

## Duration

60 minutes

### Workshop Description

- Students will be introduced to antibiotic discovery using a disc diffusion assay activity.
- Students will model enzyme activity using blocks and determine the rate at which they 'catalyse' the substrate.
- They will then take part in an enzyme inhibitor practical, using pipettes to set up an experiment which determines the impact of an inhibitor molecule on enzyme activity.
- They will use stop clocks to time how long each reaction mixture takes, and interpret the results.

#### Concepts covered

- Antibiotics
- Enzymes, substrates and inhibitors
- Antibiotic-resistant bacteria
- Drug development to fight antibiotic-resistant bugs

#### Practical Skills covered

- Negative and positive controls
- Timing reactions
- Use of Eppendorf tubes and pipettes
- Recording and interpreting results

#### Prior learning required

There are no specific requirements for this workshop. Familiarity with the concepts covered will ensure students gain the most from their time in the session.

Bug Fight! Workshops are designed for a class of students, of up to 32 students. We can deliver backto-back workshops in your school, to fit around your timetable. For example, a Bug Fight! Day might look like:
